










Population Change by Community: 2010 to 2020





### Tahoe is Getting Older


### Tahoe Region Population by Age Group

## Household Income is Rising






### **Travel Time**

- Most travel times are unchanged over past 5 years





#### US 50 EB, South Lake Y to NV State Line, Summer






### Possibly Why Tahoe Feels More Crowded


- Increases in second home use
- Increases in day-use visitation
- People are recreating and staying at different places
  - More people at previously "local's spots" because of information availability
  - Short-term rentals in neighborhoods
- Changes in travel time and behavior
  - Parking lots fill up earlier...so it feels like it is more popular
  - Roadside parking
  - Commute patterns

### Vacant Homes as a Percentage of Housing Units






### Sand Harbor Visitors- NV State Parks






### Sand Harbor Fall Weekend Trips
